ESSENTIALS

1. **Commas**
Use commas to separate items in a list.
Use commas to separate clauses in a compound sentence.
Use commas to set off a phrase or clause.

2. **Semicolons**
Use semicolons to separate items in a list when the items themselves contain commas.
Use semicolons to separate clauses in a complex sentence.

3. **Colons**
Use colons to introduce a list or a quote.
Use colons to separate a clause from a phrase or clause that explains or illustrates the clause.

4. **Quotation Marks**
Use double quotation marks for direct quotes.
Use single quotation marks for indirect quotes.
Use double quotation marks for titles of books, movies, and TV shows.
Use single quotation marks for titles of articles, chapters, and sections.

5. **Hyphens**
Use hyphens to connect words in a compound adjective.
Use hyphens to connect words in a compound noun.

6. **Capitalization**
Capitalize the first letter of a sentence.
Capitalize the first letter of a proper noun.
Capitalize the first letter of a title.

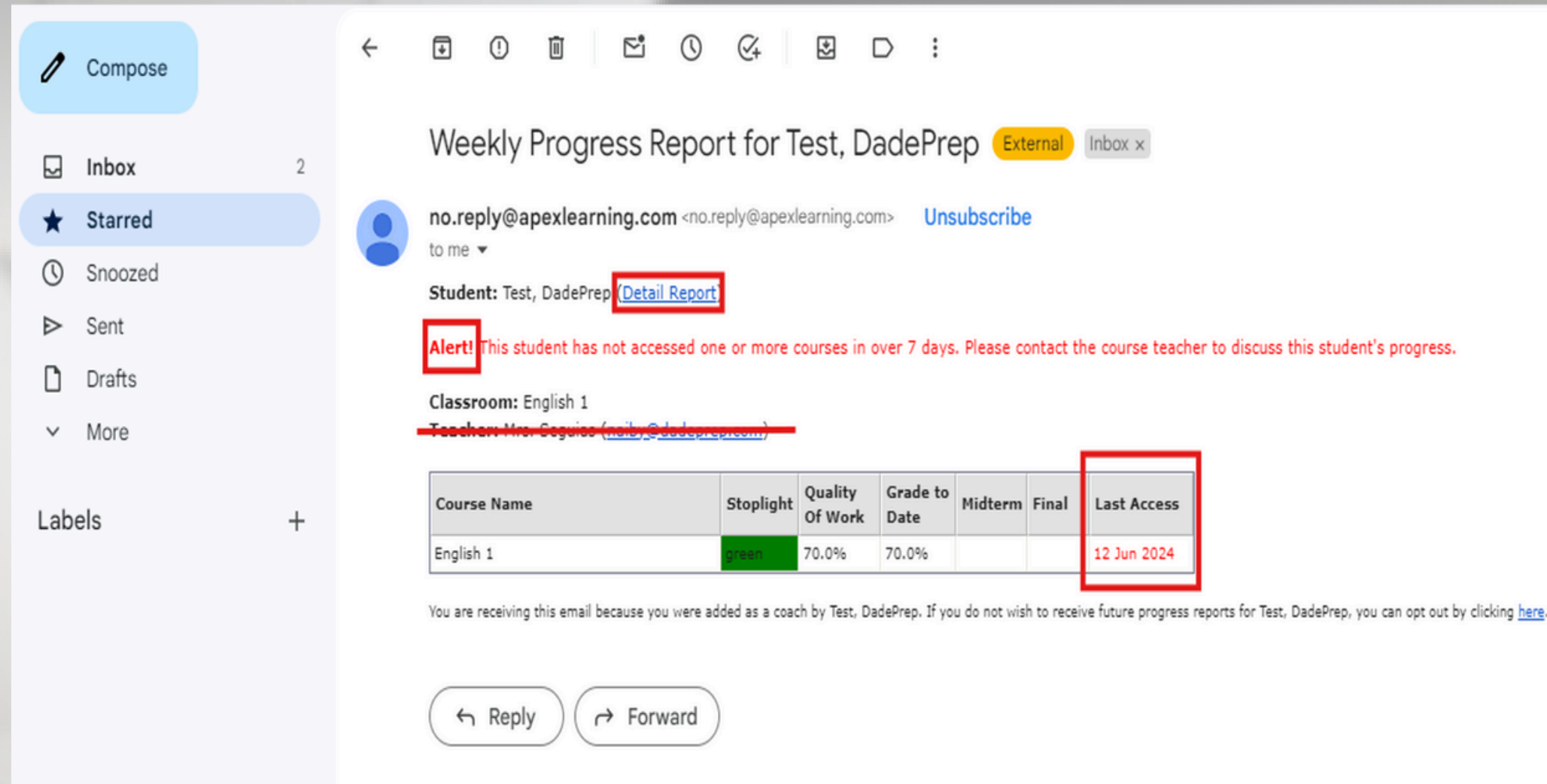

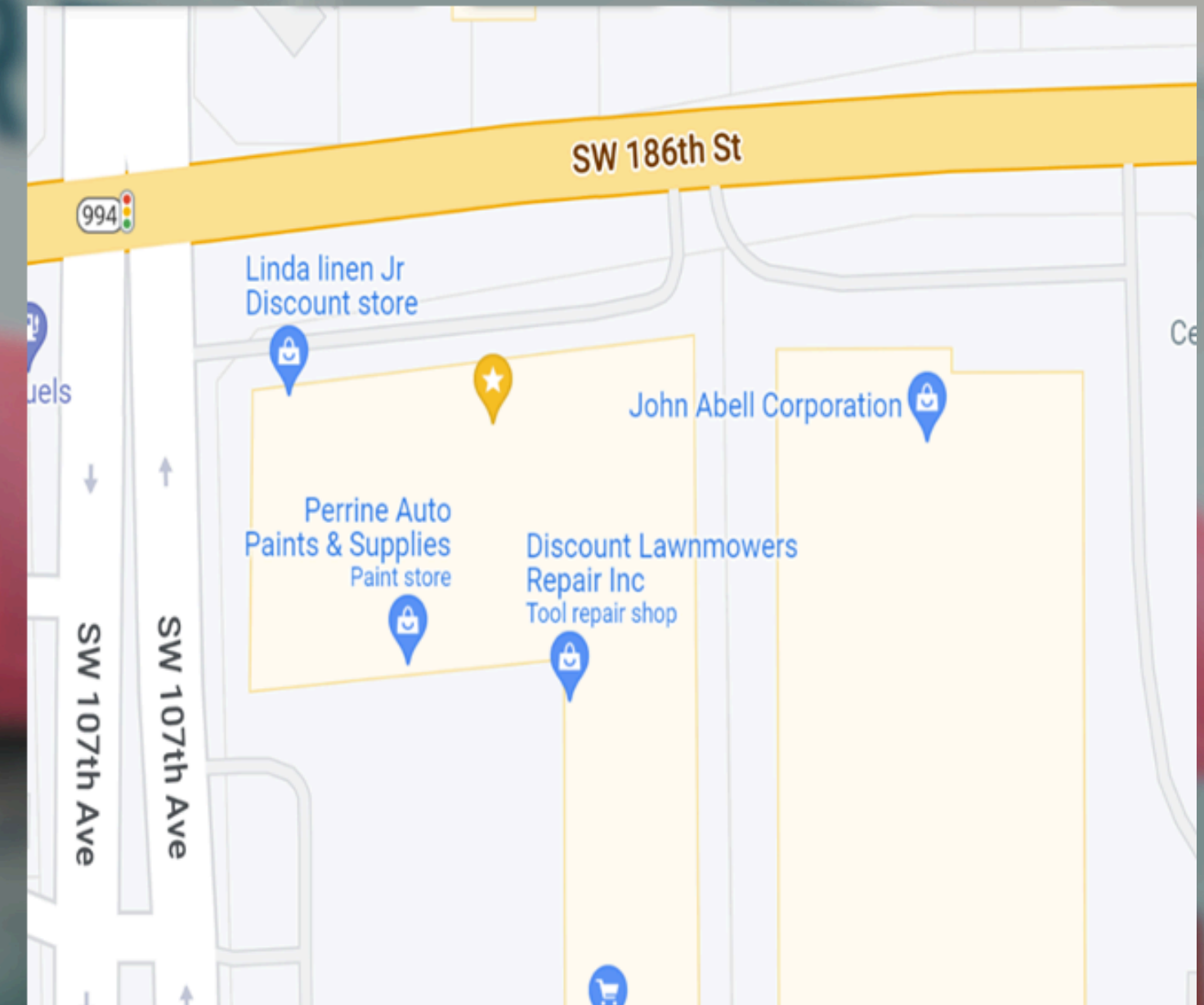
